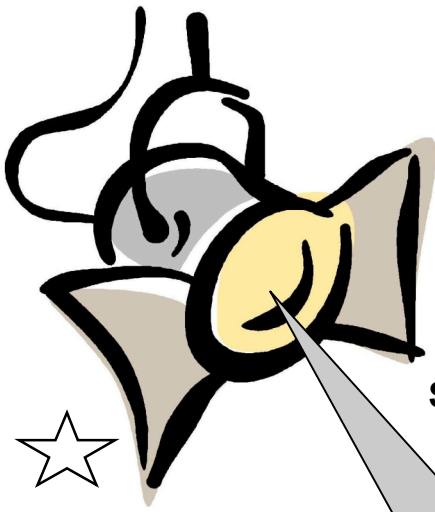


# DRAMA CAMP

## This Year's Drama Camp Sessions

### • CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

Unwrap the different characters that live inside you!

### • CHOREOGRAPHY

We'll work on fight scenes, blocking, and also stage movement.

### • COMEDY IMPROVISATION

Bring the best out of yourself by "living in the moment" on stage.

### • ACTING, READERS THEATER, AND SCRIPT WRITING

We'll work on what it truly means to be an actor or actress, and we'll practice several scenes and scripts together.

### • COSTUME DESIGN

Learn how to design great costumes for the stage.

### • MASK AND PUPPET CREATION

Create your own interesting masks and puppets in these sessions.

### • MAKE-UP DESIGN

Learn techniques of how to create a character using make-up.

### • STAGE COMBAT AND SWORD FIGHTING

Learn how to fight on the stage!

### • SET DESIGN

You'll learn how to create a set that relates to a play.

### • STORY TELLING AND MONOLOGUE

Use your voice and gestures to tell a great story.

### • MIME

Have fun showing emotion and character without speaking!
